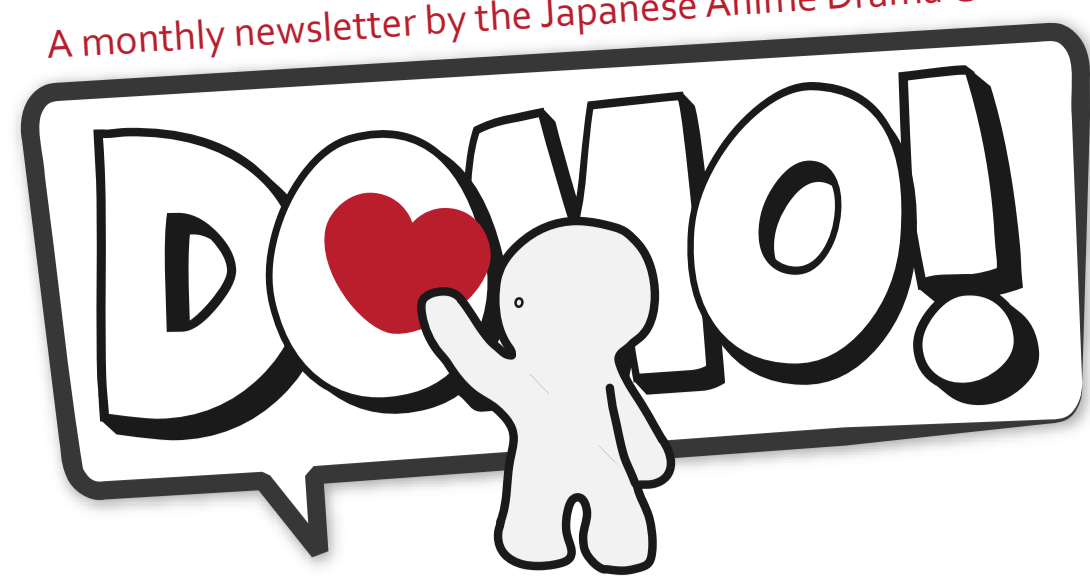

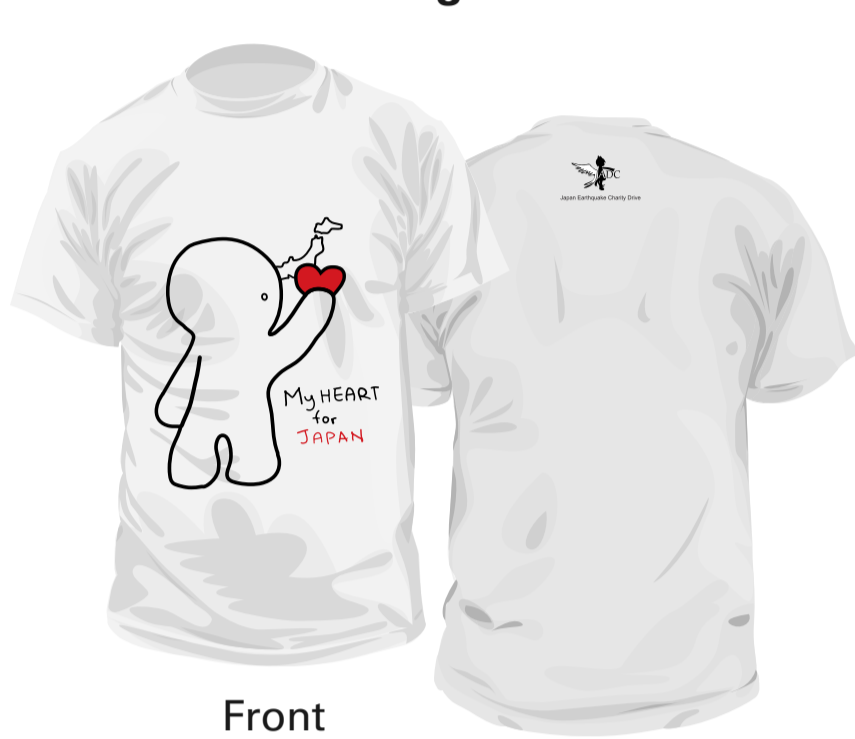

The rise of *otakus*

Have you ever thought that playing dating sims could somehow bring retribution to real life? Meet Keima Katsuragi, a 17 year old high school student who is known as the "God of Domination" for his astounding ability to "dominate" every girl in a dating sim. Because of his sole passion for dating sims, he is treated as a "ghost student" in class.

One day, he received an e-mail, challenging him to prove his title as "God of Domination" by "dominating" girls that has been provided. Keima accepts it thinking it as a game challenge, only to find that the email is actually a contract to be signed with Elsie, an agent sent from hell to collect wandering sprits hidden in the hearts of maidens. In order to exorcise the sprits in the maiden's hearts, the maiden must fall in love to fill the "gaps" left in the maiden's heart. Keima, who is trapped in a do-or-die situation caused by

Elsie's contract, is forced to use his dating sim skills to hit on real life girls.

This anime has been reviewed repeatedly as lacking in plot. But, who needs plots, where you can see a nerdy *otaku* hitting on real life girls? The strong point of this anime is the comedy brought by Keima in his efforts to get a girl. Although it contains meaningless plot that prolongs the story, it does have its own gems portrayed by Keima's attitude towards girls, made more dramatic by his own animated monologue from time to time.

What makes this anime worth watching is that, it's getting a second season in April. In the second season, the writer makes up for his lack of plot in the first season by introducing a crisis that has to be solved by Keima together with the girls that he has exorcised.
